### Task 2 - Historical Fiction - City of Thieves or The Good Earth

Time: 15 hours

Skills: Reading, Thinking, Writing, Ideation

Disposition: Curiosity

Activities:

- 1) For either book, please write a journal entry connecting the book to the essential questions. *Responses should be substantial and should utilize quotes of passages from the books*.
  - a) What does it mean to be human?
    - i) What do our stories reveal about our society?
    - ii) Are there universal truths?
  - b) How do humans interact with the environment?
  - c) How do we interact with each other?
    - i) Is citizenship a right or privilege?
    - ii) How does community shape identity?
    - iii) What obligations do we have to our community? What obligations does our community have to us? How do individuals participate in something greater than self?
    - iv) What happens when societies come into contact with one another?
    - v) Why are some values dominant over others in a particular society?

vi) To what extent does happiness connect to a sense of belonging?

# Task 3 - Golden Record Project
